Post admission requirements

Obtain a Blue Card before starting supervised professional experience. To commence field experience placement within this program, students must have a Working with Children Check.

As required by the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian Act (2000), pre-service teachers must undergo a criminal history check and be issued with a Suitability Card (Blue Card) by the Commission to allow them to undertake field experience in a school or centre in which children under 18 years of age are present. It is highly recommended that students be proactive in applying for a card as soon as they are accepted into the program. It is now a requirement of all Queensland sites and most Australian sites that pre-service teachers have obtained the Blue Card prior to starting professional learning.

- Student must be able to travel to attend professional experience placements.
- Complete and pass the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education prior to graduating.
- Complete and pass the Graduate Teacher Performance Assessment at the conclusion of their final PEx placement.
- Adhere to the Student Code of Conduct and meet Inherent Academic Requirements.
